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FINAL REPORT ON NETWORKING ACTIVITIES

The purpose of the networking activities was to gain scientific-technical and practical knowledge from different LIFE projects and others on similar subjects to the LIFE CLIMARK project in order to build the methodology for the calculation of climate credits and a credit market, as well as to help in their dissemination. This document sets out the objectives and activities carried out and the projects with which we have collaborated, as well as a brief summary of the subject matter of each activity.

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1. Objectives of the action

Networking activities with other projects on similar subjects aim to enhance the dissemination and transferability of LIFE CLIMARK and to exchange technical-scientific and practical information that could be useful in the construction of the climate credit market.

Due to the possible synergies between LIFE CLIMARK and other projects, various activities were proposed from the outset with organisations working with the COST Action “Climate-Smart Forestry in Mountain Regions”, LIFE FOREST CO2 or LIFE CANOPEE through participation in expert committees, in conferences related to the creation of credit markets in Spain and France, visits to partners in European regions and collaborations in transfer and dissemination activities. In addition, networking with local and international forest management organisations and carbon credit markets was also foreseen.

2. Networking activities

As foreseen in the project, networking activities with other projects were carried out between 2018 and 2022. A total of 16 activities were carried out, involving 16 different projects: LIFE FOREST CO2, LIFE CANOPEE, LIFE BIORGEST, LIFE GoProFor, LIFE MIDMACC, Close2Market, LIFE SORIA ForestAdapt, LIFE RESILIENT FOREST, LIFE IN COMMON LAND, LIFE EcoTimberCell, EIP-AGRI, HOLISOIL, RESONATE and LIFE CO2PES&PEF. Eleven activities were carried out online and five in person, three in Spain and two in other countries: France and Italy.

The activities dealt with the methodologies applied in the calculation of climate credits, the construction of the credit market, the possibilities of creating a credit market in several countries, strategies and measures for adapting to climate change and the impact of forestry actions on different factors, such as carbon sequestration or water availability.

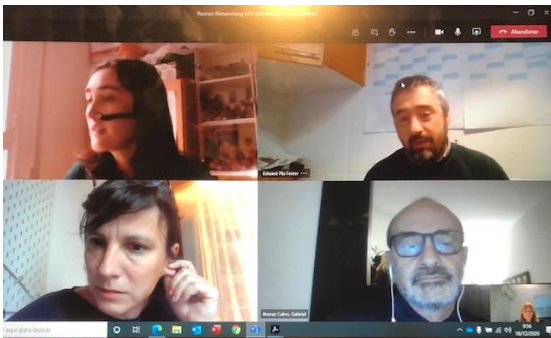

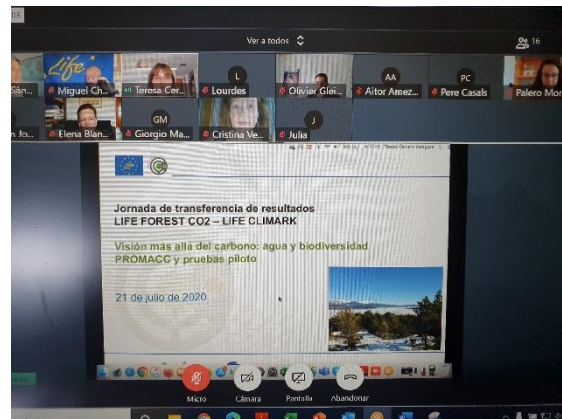

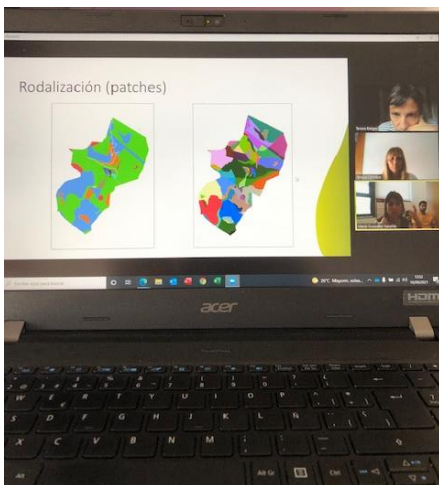

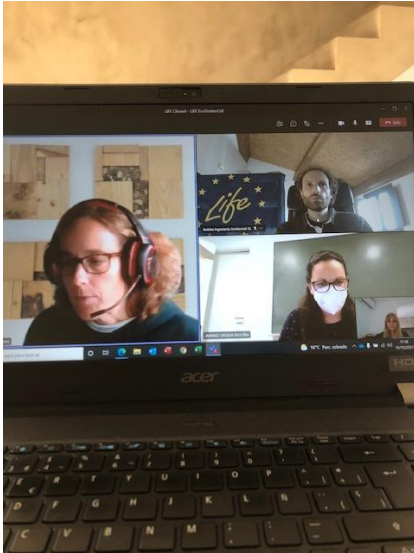
