1. Objectives of the action

To raise awareness of the LIFE CLIMARK project in the forestry sector, various sessions and presentations were planned to explain the role of forestry management in mitigating climate change and adapting woodland to it. This task is part of action E3 in the project which envisages the organisation of information sessions, workshops and the distribution of material aimed at potential promoters of climate credits, owners, professionals, technical specialists and researchers in the field of forestry.

Action E3 envisaged the organisation of two field sessions, with visits to show plots, as part of the CFC's PATT and JFEG conferences.

2. Information sessions and assessment

During the life of the project, a total of 13 information sessions have been held with different aims and target audiences, providing information on the forest ecosystem services that supply forests and forest management, about more general aspects of the LIFE CLIMARK project and its relationship to climate change, the financing of forest management and the impact of forest management on carbon, water and biodiversity.

The information sessions were aimed at a varied audience, mainly private owners and forest management companies in the region, but also multipliers, technical specialists and trainees, undergraduates and university students.

The sessions have been held in face-to-face format, except for two sessions in 2021, which were online, making it possible to reach a larger number of people. In some cases attendance was limited due to COVID-19 but we managed to reach 20-35 people.

Most of the sessions were organised by other entities in the sector and training organisations, secondary schools and the University of Lleida. Some have been local in scope (Vallcebre, Prades de la Molsosa, Montmell, Orpí), while others have reached a wide audience from all over Catalonia.

Of the total number of sessions, three were part of the DACC "Annual Technology Transfer Plan" (PATT), while one was part of the CFC's "Emili Garolera Forestry Workshops".
